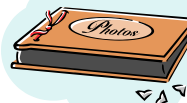

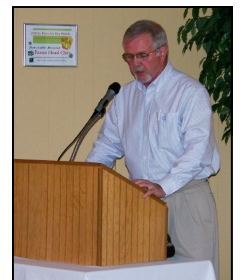

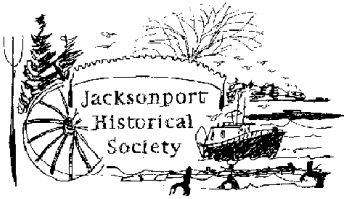
Leslie Bellais, curator of costume & textiles at the Wisconsin Historical Society, Madison explored the reasons for the change from bonnets to hats.
